## Being a Good **SAMARITAN**

In the parable of the "Good Samaritan," a traveler leaving Jerusalem was stripped, beaten, and left for dead. As the traveler was lying on the road, an ordinary man from a Samaria passed by. This Samaritan fixed up the stripped and beaten traveler and set him up with lodging and care. Many individuals throughout San Diego can relate to how this traveler leaving Jerusalem must have felt. As the Samaritan stepped up and helped, so too has the Rock A.R.M.Y. The fire victims in this parable, greatly resembles the beaten traveler and the "Good Samaritan" is you.

## A Message from Miles

hank you Rock Church! In a time of need, you answered the call to support the San Diego wildfire relief efforts. The Rock A.R.M.Y. was ready and equipped; and sent out to help. At 5:08 PM on Monday, an email was sent to over 11,000 members, followed by a text message to 3,500 cell phones. That evening donations started coming in for evacuees and 1,000 volunteers responded by donating their time to Qualcomm Stadium and answering 211 calls.

Tuesday morning the Rock answered God's call to open as an Evacuation Center. We quickly became a safe and comfortable refuge for over 300 people, and a Supply Distribution Center that collected and distributed items to over 10,000 evacuees. The Rock A.R.M.Y. provided San Diego with over 1500 cases of water, 5000 kitchen items, 3000 clothing items and 6000 personal items. Our efforts were recognized by the OES (Office of Emergency Services) and was qualified to become an official American Red Cross center with a fully staffed medical center.

After being in our new home for less than two months the Rock Church was able to serve our community in an amazing new way. To all 2,000 Rock Church Disaster Relief Volunteers, thank you!
