## 1. Opening Prayer

# NEW! Recite the Difference Maker's Prayer

"As a Difference-Making Disciple, I am pursuing the heart of the Father, a heart that is being perfected in love for God and people.

Father give me a heart that:

- Desperately seeks face-to-face intimacy with You.
- Gracefully gives and receives forgiveness.
- Nurtures a burden for lost people.
- Serves with humility.

Jesus, create in me a heart that:

- Demonstrates a commitment to a Spirit-filled expression of my gifts.
- Faithfully avoids that which distracts me from obeying You.
- Humbly embraces a kingdom mindset.
- Values making disciples that multiply.

Holy Spirit, develop a heart in me that:

- Values being guided by the Word of God.
- Is dependent on the power of prayer.
- Gratefully grows in generosity.
- Passionately worships the fullness of God.

Father, with Christlikeness as my goal and the Holy Spirit as my Guide, knit my heart with Yours. Fill my heart with Your love for all people. In Jesus' Name, Amen."

# 3. Discussion Time

  - What help do you need?
  - Who will you share your faith with this week?

#### 4. Review the Sunday Sermon notes

On Sunday, Pastor Greg opened his message sharing about a community Thanksgiving event where he was serving food to homeless people. He noticed a homeless man serving food to those in attendance. When Pastor Greg asked him about it, the man replied, "I didn't come here to be served, I came to serve," and added that he knew the Bible and what Jesus has done for us. What a testimony of humility, not only to Pastor Greg, but others who were there. This homeless man was indeed a Difference Maker.

We, also as Difference Makers, need to realize that our humble service starts with godly SUBMISSION. Our service should not only be humble, but reflecting God, even in pressured situation. In addition, our humble service should bring STRENGTH to others around us, with no personal agenda. Be completely submitted to the Lord, bringing all glory to God. Finally, our humble service should REFLECT the one who served us first. When we humble ourselves, we empty ourselves which then allows the Holy Spirit to fill us.
