D12 Monthly Focus for September: Guided by the Word of God

1. Opening Prayer

- Pray together (thank God for something, pray for others, and pray for self)

Recite the Difference Maker's Prayer

“As a Difference-Making Disciple, I am pursuing the heart of the Father, a heart that is being perfected in love for God and people.

Father, give me a heart that:

- Desperately seeks face-to-face intimacy with You.
- Gracefully gives and receives forgiveness.
- Nurtures a burden for lost people.
- Serves with humility.

Jesus, create in me a heart that:

- Demonstrates a commitment to a Spirit-filled expression of my gifts.
- Faithfully avoids that which distracts me from obeying You.
- Humbly embraces a kingdom mindset.
- Values making disciples that multiply.

Holy Spirit, develop a heart in me that:

- Values being guided by the Word of God.
- Is dependent on the power of prayer.
- Gratefully grows in generosity.
- Passionately worships the fullness of God.

Father, with Christlikeness as my goal and the Holy Spirit as my Guide, knit my heart with Yours. Fill my heart with Your love for all people. In Jesus' Name, Amen.”

2. Review this month's MEMORY VERSE

“All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness.” ~2 Timothy 3:1-6 NKJV

3. Discussion Time - begin with key insights from your daily journal and allow the Holy Spirit to guide your discussion.

- What is the Holy Spirit teaching or revealing to you?
- What is a current challenge you are dealing with?
- What step will you take to be more obedient to him?
- What help do you need?
- Who will you share your faith with this week?

4. Review the Sunday Sermon notes

On Sunday 9/6, Pastor Jason spoke to us about Groups and being with people, just as Jesus was with His disciples.

1. **Discipleship ministry begins with a CALL.** God is calling you to invite someone into a purposeful relationship. Who has God put around you, a neighbor, family member, or friend, to begin a discipleship relationship?
2. **Mentor from where you ARE, not where you want to be.** Some will accept the message you have, and others will reject you, but be faithful in representing Christ. What are some ways you are helping train someone else to lead?
3. **Multiplication requires RISK and RELEASE.** Be ready to “let go,” knowing that you will have to release those you are leading, to begin mentoring and leading others. Releasing is not cutting someone off. What are some fears keeping you from “letting people go to lead on their own?”

5. Closing Prayer

- Share prayer requests and pray for each other.
