TITLE: Salvation, Simple as ABC

MEMORY VERSE: "For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes." **Romans 1:16a**

SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1. Read **Genesis 3:6,7, and 21** How did Adam attempt to "cover" himself? Why was that unsatisfactory to God? How did God "cover" Adam and Eve? Why was the shedding of blood necessary?
- 2. Read **Isaiah 9:6** and go around your Small Group and share personally how Jesus fulfills these attributes in your life. (Example How is Jesus WONDERFUL to you?)
- 3. Go around your Small Group and read **Psalm 22** and **Isaiah 53** our loud. Make a mental note of all the ways Jesus fulfilled these prophesies. Remember they were written over seven hundred years before the birth of Jesus.

DAILY BIBLE READING

4. Read and compare **2 Chronicles 16:9** and **2 Chronicles 25:1-2**. What does it mean to have a loyal heart? What does God provide for those whose hearts are loyal? What description are we given of Amaziah? What does this passage mean to you?

- 5. How can you trust a God you have never seen? How can you prove that God exists?
- 6. How can God send good people to hell?
- 7. Did Jesus ever claim to be God, the Savior, or the Christ?
