SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1. Why did Jonah run from God? What are some ways you are running away from God? Why? Did Jonah escape God? What can we learn from this?
- 2. God wants to do BIG things through you, not because of you. What do you think some of those things might be? What steps are you taking to make those things happen? Who's keeping you accountable to do those things?
- 3. Why don't we see God in our lives? Where do you miss Him most in your life? How can you improve at seeing Him?

DAILY WALK – ISAIAH (reflections from Isaiah 29–31)

- 1. These three chapters foretell coming judgment. Take a moment and ponder the question as to why God judges His people. Now discuss the following concepts:
 - a. The blindness of disobedience Isaiah 29:9-16
 - b. False Confidence Isaiah 30:1-3
 - c. The folly of not trusting God **Isaiah 31:1-3**

DIGGING DEEPER (from Stone Tablets)

- 1. What are the differences between the crossing of the Jordan and the parting of the Red Sea? (Read **Joshua 3** and **Exodus 14:21**)
- 2. What were the purposes of the stones of remembrance? (**Joshua 4**) What memorials have you erected?
- 3. Who was the commander of the Lord's army **Joshua 5**
- 4. Who actually fought the battle of Jericho? **Joshua 6**
