- 1. What is the theme of the story of **John 13:1-17**? How does Jesus define love?
- 2. How does Jesus' upside-down Gospel affect your personal world? What specific changes does it force you to make?
- 3. If love is truly a verb, how do you love those closest to you? In what ways do you, like Peter, say "no!" to God?

DAILY WALK - JEREMIAH

1. Review **Jeremiah 46-52**. Do you see similarities between Jeremiah's pluralistic world and ours today? Do you think the same judgments prophesied in his day could be applicable in ours?

DIGGING DEEPER (from Stone Tablets)

- 1. To whom were the final prophecies of Jeremiah directed? What caused the people to ignore them?
- 2. Last week we mentioned that Jeremiah was the only Old Testament prophet to mention the New Testament, but how do the two covenants relate to one another?
- 3. How do you think Jeremiah would change his prophecies if he were to give them in the American Church today? Would he change them at all?
