SERMON REFLECTIONS - CHRIS JOHNSON

Chris's sermon was from the entire chapter of Matthew 10. It would be good to read this chapter together before taking on the questions.

- 1. Share with your Group what it means to you to be a true disciple of Jesus Christ.
- 2. What is your personal cost as far as discipleship? Review the following:
 - a. Have you attached yourself to Jesus to learn the trade of soul winning?
 - b. Have you left home to move in with Jesus?
 - c. Do you trust that Jesus will provide all your needs?
 - d. Does Jesus have total authority over you?
 - e. Are you his servant?
 - f. Are you willing to become like Jesus in character and transmit this character to others?

SERMON REFLECTION - JUSTIN ANDERSON

- 1. What areas in your life have you been an unworthy servant? How has Satan tempted you with laziness?
- 2. What excuses do you give God for not investing your talents? What do your actions say about your faith?
- 3. What has God entrusted to you? How are you going to act in faith using the "talents" God has given you?
