- 3. How has the evidence presented thus far in this series challenged your thinking about origins? What has it changed about the way you look at the Bible? What has it done for your faith?

With The ROCK University offering an Ecclesia Series class on the Book of Romans, we felt it was appropriate for the instructor, Pastor Kyle Osland to give us our discussion questions for the week as we conclude this epistle.

- 1. When Paul say's that we are in Christ, what does he mean (**Romans 8:1**)?
- 2. If the cultural issue of Paul's day was whether or not Gentiles should be circumcised, what would be our issues today (i.e. sexuality, music etc.)?
- 3. What use does the Law have today?
- 4. Are the Jewish people who don't know Christ going to be saved?
- 5. Where does God's sovereignty end and our free will begin? (Are they compatible?)
