MEMORY VERSE: And they devoted themselves to the apostles teaching, to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayers. **Acts 2:42**

SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1. What can we learn and apply to our lives with the Jewish celebrations of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur? (For more biblical information, read **Galatians 3:24**; **Hebrews 9**; **Leviticus 16 and Exodus 30**)
- 2. What are the things listed in **Acts 2:42** that those of the early church were DEVOTED to? Share the areas you need to devote yourself to in this year.
 - (2 Timothy 2:15; 2 Timothy 3:14-17; Luke 10:42; Hebrews 10:19-25; John 13:34-35)

CLOSER WALK (John 4-7)

- 1. In **John 4:1-42** we have the encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman. As you read this passage be sure to take in the following:
 - Review Jesus' method in witnessing
 - The difference between regular water and living water
 - Did you know that some cults claim that Jesus never claimed to actually be the Messiah what does **vs. 26** say about that?
 - The concept of sowing and reaping
 - The value of a personal testimony
- 2. What are the fourfold witnesses Jesus referred to in **4:31-47**?
- 3. **John 6** is loaded: three things to note: (1) Andrew he seemed to have a 1 on 1 sort of ministry. While others dwelt with crowds, Andrew is always bringing one person to Jesus (besides this lad here, what other examples can you find?) (2) What are the dangers attached to "miracles"? (3) Note the ominous **6:66** verse: why did the crowds walk away? Why could Peter not walk away?

Make sure you know your memory verse! Acts 2:42
