SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1. The Rock Church exists to lead people into a life-changing and productive relationship with Jesus Christ. Please define what you think life-changing means. What does productive mean? As you look at your own walk, are you engaged in a life changing and productive relationship with Jesus Christ? If not, why?
- 2. Our lives are the only Bible that some people may ever read. In **Joshua 7**, Achan was in sin. What impact would his sin have on the people around him, watching his life? **Joshua 7:12** talks about the consequences of sin, how did Achins sin affect the Israelites? How does you sin affect those around you? Share with your accountability partner of the areas in your life that are affecting others.
- 3. What must we do once we realize that we have "sin in the camp"? Read **Joshua 7:19-21**, and discuss what the Israelites did. **2 Chron. 7:14-15** talks about healing the land once the people turn from their wicked ways. Can this apply to us in America? Discuss what we as a people can do today to heal our land.

CLOSER WALK (Romans)

- 1. People talk about 'hearing God'. What lesson do we learn from Abraham? (**Romans 4:20-21**) Do we have similar promises? Slowly review **2 Peter 1:2-4** and **1:17-21**. With this greatest of all experiences Peter tells us to heed what as more important (1:19). See a pattern?
- 2. **Romans 4:25** is often missed by many believers. We understand that Jesus was delivered up because of our sins (**Isaiah 53:4-6** and **John 19:30**) ... but if there was one sin unpaid for, or anything left to do to concerning our salvation then Jesus would have remained in the grave. But **Romans 4:25** states He was "raised up" to prove our what?
- 3. Victory over sin: What am I to know? Romans 6:3,6,9. What am I to recon, consider, or believe? Romans 6:11. And, what am I to do? Romans 6:13
