Title: What Does Wisdom Say – Part 7

MEMORY VERSE: The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction. **Proverbs 1:7**

SERMON REFLECTIONS

- 1) In **1 Kings 3:1-15**, we read about the dialog between God and Solomon, where God is asking Solomon what He should give him. In the sermon, Miles brought up three key points to learn from this dialogue.
 - a) Solomon's request was based on Gods plan for his life. Do you know what Gods plan is for your life? What are your spiritual gifts? Discuss why this is important to know (**Eph 2:10**). If you have never taken the spiritual gifts test, follow the link below and take the test.

- b) Solomon's request was based on his desire to do a good job (1 Kings 3:8-9, Col 3:23, 1 Cor 3:13). Are people watching your work ethic, habits, and schedule? Why is it so important to do a good job? Do we work for God or for man?
- c) Solomon's request was based on acknowledging his weakness (1 Kings 3:7, 2 Cor 12:9-10, Rm 8:26). Do you know what your weaknesses are? Can God still use you if you are weak? When are you more effective for God, when you are weak or when you are strong? Why?

CLOSER WALK (Colossians)

- 1. Have your Small Group read aloud **Colossians 1 and 2**. Appoint a scribe and list all the things that speak of Christ being preeminent. Take a moment to discuss the relevancy of his preeminence to the way you live your life.
- 2. Read **Genesis 1:1-3**, **John 1:1-5**, **Proverbs 8:22-36**, and **Colossians 1:16-17**. What light do these verses shed on creation and the role of Jesus at the time of the creation?
- 3. If Colossians 1-2 are "theological," then 3-4 are "practical." Go around the room again and read these two chapters aloud. Compose a personal list of the things that are relevant to you (things that you might need to focus on). As you feel led, share the some of you discoveries with your Group.
