Title: The Adam's Family Salvation, Part I

MEMORY VERSE: And so it is written, "The first man Adam became a living being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. **1 Corinthians 15:45**

SERMON REFLECTIONS

(Romans 4:7-8) These questions have been designed to give you a clearer understanding of Salvation and the various aspects that make up salvation.

- 1) <u>Salvation</u> Discuss what salvation is and is not (review notes). How would you explain salvation to a non-believer? Why should you be excited about sharing salvation with others?
- 2) <u>Depravity</u> (**Eph 2:1**) What does it mean to have depravity? Does everyone have this? What is the answer, or cure, for our depravity? As a believer do you still experience depravity?
- 3) <u>Born Again</u> (Jn 1:11, Jn 3:1) How would you explain being "born again" to a non-believer? Can non-Christians be born again? What is the youngest age that someone can be born again? (*Answer: as soon as they can understand the Gospel of Jesus Christ, and can make the decision on their own.*)
- 4) <u>Justified</u> (**Rom 5:1-2**) Are you justified today, right now, before God? What does it take to be justified before God? Can you lose this?
- 5) <u>Forgiven</u> (**Heb 8:12**) How would you explain forgiveness to a non-believer? Can this be taken away from us? Explain how being forgiven and asking for forgiveness go hand in hand. Do you have to ask for forgiveness to be forgiven? How often do we have to ask for forgiveness?
- 6) <u>Adoption</u> (Eph 1:5, Gal 4:5, Rom 9:4) Define adoption. Why is it important to understand our adoption into Gods family? Can we get kicked out? Can we kick others out?
- 7) Gospel (1 Cor 15:3, Mk 1:14-15, Mk 13:10) Define Gospel. Is the Gospel designed for everyone, or only certain people? Is it good news for everyone, or only those who believe? How would you explain this to a non-believer?
- 8) <u>Propitiation</u> (Rom 3:23, Heb 2:17, 1 Jn 2:2, 1 Jn 4:10) How would you explain this to a 12 year old? Why is this an important concept to understand?
- 9) <u>Atonement</u> (Lev 23:28, Lev 17:11, Ezek 16:33) Define atonement. Have you ever made atonement for someone else? What happens to us if Christ had not made atonement?
- 10) <u>Impute</u> (Rom 4:11, Ps 32:2, Rom 4:6) This means to assign as credit. What is credit? Why is this needed? How would you explain this to a non-believer?

PRAYER TIME

Spend some time in prayer with your accountability partner. Pray that God would grant you a deeper, richer understanding of the gift of salvation. Pray for a divine appointment / opportunity for you to share your faith this week!
