3. Discussion Questions

- 1) Last week we spent some time talking about marriage, and the principles of the marriage of Adam and Eve that can be compared to The Bride of Christ and the Church. (See Study Guide & Questions from January 11, 2004).
 - a) Consider this passage, and discuss the implications of divorce. (Matthew 19:3-9, Deuteronomy 24:1-5, Jeremiah 3:1-2; 7-9, Mark 10:1-12)
 - b) Define Adultery (Matthew 19:9)
 - c) What about this be applied to our lives today?
- 2) Love and relationships
 - a) How do you know that someone loves you?
 - b) What does it mean to "Love God" (1 John 5:3, Matthew 27:37-40)
 - c) Discuss the following thought, "Either you love God and obey Him, or you do not love Him and do not obey Him....you cannot have it both ways."
 - d) Define "Love" in your own words.
 - e) Look in your sermon notes and discuss the four characteristics of someone who "loves" you.
 - 1. Can you have "true" love with someone who does not love God?
- 3) Why is it not good for man to be alone? (Genesis 1:28)
- 4) The definition of lust is "Pleasing self at the expense of others". The devil, and our flesh will tell you to use your power and ability to get what you think you need...and not allowing you to be happy with what God has brought you.
 - a) Why do we lust?
 - b) How do you combat lust?
 - c) Do you have an accountability partner that you can share your struggles with? Are you being honest with that person?
