- 4) Read **Leviticus 20:13.** Please discuss the verse.
 - a) What is an "abomination"?

 - a) What correlation do you see between instances of abuse and homosexuality?
 - b) Consider the aforementioned statistic, and discuss some of the ways you may be able to minister to a person engaged in a homosexual lifestyle.
