Genesis 3

1. Announcements

3. Discussion Questions

- 1) Genesis 3:14-15
 - a. Why did God curse the serpent first?
 - b. Define cursed. What other instance is the word "cursed" used?
 - c. Notice God did not curse man, why? (Genesis 1:28)
 - d. Define the word "enmity" in verse 15.
 - e. "Her seed" is written of in verse 15, who is that? (Offspring Gen 15:3; Descendants Gen 15:5, 13, 18; Individual Gal 3:16; messianic term Num 24:7, Is 6:13) See also John 8:37-47.
 - f. This verse is sometimes referred to as, "The First Gospel." Why?

2) Genesis 3:17-19

- a. How would cursing the ground affect man? Why was this a problem for man?
- b. Death in Adam Life in Christ (Romans 5:12-21)
 - i. What did we inherit through Adam? (Rom 5:12-14)
 - ii. What did we gain through Christ (Rom 5:15)
 - iii. Define Condemnation
 - iv. Define Justification

3) The Stations of The Cross

- a. What did you learn about Jesus through the Stations of the Cross? What impact does that have on you?
- b. "My sin put Jesus Christ on the cross." What does that mean to you?
- c. How would you explain the symbolism of the Stations of the Cross to a non-believer?
