### 3. Discussion Questions

- 1) Arrogance and Pride led David into sin. (Psalm 26)
  - a. Define Arrogance, Define Pride.
  - b. How does pride make us fall? (Prov.16:18)
  - c. How would an accountability partner have changed this scenario?
- 2) Satan's most common lie is "No one will find out".
  - a. Why is this a lie?
  - b. No matter how private your sin may be, who always sees? (Heb. 4:13)
- 3) "This book {the Bible} will keep you from sin or sin will keep you from this book."
  - a. Do you agree with this quote?
  - b. How does Scripture keep us from sin? (Matt. 4:1-11)
- 4) David fell into sin by looking at temptation from the rooftop of his palace.
  - a. What sin are you looking at from the rooftop?
  - b. How do you get away from that sin and temptation?
  - c. What's your way of escape? (I Cor. 10:13)
- 5) Explain the importance of David's response when he was confronted with his sin.
  - a. How did this response help him to return to God?
  - b. How do you respond when God or someone else confronts you with sin? Do you wallow in it or repent immediately? (Il Sam. 12:13)
- 6) In **II Sam. 7: 8-17**, God made a covenant with David to bless him, yet David choose to settle for second best by being with Bathsheba.
  - a. Is there anything your settling for instead of waiting for God's best?
