Purpose: To examine what Spiritual Life "looks like" and how to get it.

Prayer: If you missed our Leadership Event or Dunamis, then you missed the announcement that Pastor Dan is being "reassigned" for the Lord. He has been given an amazing opportunity to serve alongside Chuck Missler at Koinonia House in Idaho. Please keep him and his wife Sharon in your prayers during this last month in San Diego!

Connect:

- 1. What was your life like before Christ? How would you have responded if someone told you that you were dead? (Would you have welcomed the opportunity to hear more? Was your life so great that you would have been offended?)
- 2. How do you define "living life to the fullest?" Do you experience life to the fullest with a particular person, place, or situation? When do you "savor" life?

Grow:

- 1. When we were dead in our transgressions, we were "gratifying the cravings of our sinful nature and following its desires and thoughts." (Ephesians 2:3) Consider your daily life. Are you still living according to your old sinful nature, or are your actions consistent with your true identity in Christ? (2 Corinthians 5:17; Ephesians 1:4; Romans 8:9-11; Colossians 2:13)
- 2. Read **John 6:25-35**; **John 3:1-21**. As Christians, we talk about having "Life in the Spirit." What does this passage teach us about living in the Spirit? How do you explain this to a non-believer?
- 3. Read **Luke 7:36-50**. How does the "sinful" woman demonstrate her life in the Spirit? What does she teach us about what it means to be "alive?"

Live:

- I. If "the dead demonstrate a life screaming for CPR," what about all the "good" people that don't know Christ? How do you approach someone that does not appear to be crying for help? (1 Corinthians 1:18)
- 2. Is it easy for non-believers and baby Christians to see that you are "alive" in Christ? Jesus speaks of "putting a light on a stand" so that it can give light to the fullest. How do you put your *life* on a stand?
- 3. What will you do in order to nurture your life in the Spirit? After sharing with the group, spend some time with your accountability partner praying for one another.
