Marriage is challenging enough as it is, but Brian and Haley's situation has brought additional challenges to their relationship, yet they not only have stayed together; they have thrived! How/why do you think this is the case?

God allowed a VERY challenging circumstance to happen to this couple, but He did not leave them to make it through on their own. It is very obvious that it would take supernatural strength to thrive in their circumstance, and that is exactly what they are doing. What does this tell you about God and where He is at when trials come our way?

God gave them the strength to have victory in their challenges, but it was up to Brian and Haley to use that strength. God always gives us what we need to make it, but we sometimes refuse to use his strength, and we try to do it our way. Why is that?

Brian said that we all have problems, but what's important is what your source of strength is. Why is God the ultimate source of strength, and why can it be challenging to rely on Him instead of ourselves?

In the world's eyes, this accident is a complete tragedy. Most people wouldn't want to live after such an event, but that's not Brian's attitude. How did he look at his circumstance, and compare it to how you look at trials in your lives?
