OPENING DISCUSSION

EXPLORING THE TOPIC

Perspective: We don't need to live in fear of Satan and demons because Jesus has already defeated Satan, Jesus is more powerful, and you have the Holy Spirit living within you!

"I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."

John 16:33

"Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for he who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

1 John 4:4

Read 1 Peter 5:8-9

What are the commands in this passage?	
What are the reasons given for the commands?	

Who does this passage say that the devil's adversary is?



Contrary to popular belief, Satan and God are *not* arch-enemies. God is the sovereign creator of all, and Satan is one of his creations. Although he is a defeated foe, he still is on the attack and we are called to resist by standing firm in our faith. James 4:7 tells us to submit to God, resist the devil, and then he'll flee from us. When you abide in Christ, you have all authority in Christ and the devil is powerless before Christ!

The Two-fold LIE

Pastor Miles said that Satan uses a two-fold lie to keep us from living the way God wants us to:

- "Sin has no consequence"
- "You can be your own god making up your own rules"

Paul uses the title "god of this world" for Satan. What does that mean?
How do you think that Satan has shaped the culture of our nation?

Satan has a strategic campaign to lead people away from God and take them captive to do his will instead of God's (2 Tim 2:26). Jesus came to destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8), and to plunder his household (Mark 3:27). As his followers, we are called to walk in the victory and freedom that he gives, and then to engage in the spiritual battle and lead those in bondage to be set free!
