SHARING YOUR TESTIMONY - WHAT IN LIFE IS REALLY WORTH FIGHTING FOR

Pastor Miles McPherson interviews UFC champion Ken Shamrock – June 14, 2015

Pastor Miles conducted powerful interview with world acclaimed MMA fighter, UFC Champion, and Pro-Wrestler, Ken Shamrock who shared his inspiring testimony about facing and overcoming terrible adversity from his youth and now uses his influence as a platform to bring hope to others.

MEMORY VERSE

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death. **Revelation 12:11 (NKJV)**

DISCUSSION STARTERS

Has anyone ever wrestled, boxed or had a fight? How long did it <u>seem</u> to last? How long did it actually last?

Mixed Martial Arts and Ultimate Fighting Champion rounds are 5 minutes with 1 minute between rounds. The professional athletes in these events are among the most elite in the world. Most beginners, even those in great shape, are astonished how long a round seems to last. Many compare a single round to lasting an eternity, and being totally exhausted.

What does it take to get into TOP SPIRITUAL SHAPE so we can be equipped to fight the enemy? What does it take to remain in TOP SPIRITUAL SHAPE?

During the discussion with Pastor Miles, Ken shared about his first morning at a new school when he was challenged to a fight later on - right after school. Instead of waiting, Ken knocked down his challenger right then and there. How can we fight off the devil immediately instead of waiting until the enemy has taken a good hold on us and affected our relationship with God?

For those hearing the testimony, what is your response and what encouragement did you get from hearing someone's testimony?

- [2] During the discussion, Pastor Miles spoke about people searching for God all of our life and seeking a relationship through all of our "stuff" and "issues". Often we try to fill that longing for a satisfying relationship with idolizing worldly things like a career, or family or addiction or abuse or other sinful behavior that puts God secondary. We are all on the same path, it just looks different. How did someone else's sharing help build your relationship with God?
- [3] Pastor Miles said "If you surrender your life to God, you have to live it." What does surrender mean to you and what does it look like in your life?
- [4] Sometimes we have thoughts in our head we use to rationalize why we do not do something especially things God has placed on our heart, or is telling us to do something. Many times, when we actually say what those excuses are, they become much weaker reasons to delay actions. What are some of the reasons we use to rationalize or delay taking action when God is calling us to change or do something?

[5] Read Ephesians 6:10-17

Have everyone silently reflect for a few minutes on this passage and what God is calling us to do that will draw us closer to Hs presence and improve our relationship with Him. After reflection, have everyone get into groups of 2 or 3 and share what truth was experienced or revealed.

[6] Go to Gospel central and find a story that you identify with. Share with the group what made that story appeal or encourage you.
