Encouragement: Some of the many lies of the devil are: God doesn't listen to you, you've got some work to do before you're ready to go to Him, you're not a disciple, who are you to speak on His behalf, you haven't changed at all, you won't amount to anything, you can't do this. Which of the "I am" Statements from the backside of this week's lesson plan can be used against these lies?

We have three distinct identities as people: A physical one (our bodies), a personal one (our souls) and a spiritual one (our spirit). Our spirit communicates to and with the Holy Spirit in which <u>four</u> of the following ways? a. Through God's Word b. Through Prayer c. Through circumstance d. Through the church (His people) e. Through our feelings and emotions

Our bodies, souls, and spirits all need to be fed. Is our soul fed with the same thing our spirit is fed with? What are some of the differences? What happens when our spirit is not fed?

Scripture: 2 Corinthians 5:17 says we are new creations in Christ. What part of your identity has changed, or become new since your salvation? Have or would people who know you notice?

James 1:23-24 tells us that "Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like" who? What part of our own identity could be guilty of the charge James makes in the rest of this verse?

Miles explained how he looks to his left when he is in prayer with the Father, and being seated at His right hand! The apostle Paul backs him us in Ephesians 2:6 saying "And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus." How can we be seated at his right hand or in the heavenly places while we are still here on earth?

**Prayer:** When we understand what our true identity is, we are now ready to act and serve correctly. Bearing fruit in our true purpose. Each of us have different roles to fill. If you do not know your **Kingdom Purpose** I'll tell you. To know God and to make Him known. If you do not know your **Kingdom Identity** read and pray over each of the I am statements in today's lesson plan (attached).
