Ice Breaker:

Scripture:

Genesis 3:12-13. Both Adam and Eve blamed someone else for their sin.

Ephesians 6:12. Pastor Miles asked if any of us had "issues" or a disagreement with someone, explain how is that NOT 'wrestling' against flesh and blood but instead a spiritual battle.

John 8:44. In this passage, how does Jesus describe the devil to the Jews? If the devil has never obeyed the truth, why is it so easy at times to believe the lies of the devil?



Prayer:

The only way to destroy the works of the devil is to have Christ in your life. Their may be some people in your group who have not accepted Christ this is the only way to destroy the works of the devil. Challenge your group in the salvation prayer. The second group of people who have already accepted Christ may need too recommit to Christ so the next prayer would be that people would be filled with the Holy Spirit to break the strongholds in their life. Lead them in prayer to be baptized in the Holy Spirit. (Baptism in the Holy Spirit.)



Next Steps:

When Pastor Miles asked the church how many of us knew they were about to sin and still did it anyway, almost all of us raised a hand! We all know better - but the serpent was cleverer than any of the wild animals the LORD God had made. This week challenge your group to memory the scripture below:

Memory Verse: Ephesians 6:12 " For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places."

Challenge your members with the following:
