Encouragement:

Pastor Keith opened up his message describing the importance of discovering your divine fingerprint and making an imprint.

- 1. What imprint do you believe God is calling you to make on the world?

- 3. What does this statement mean to you? (Your Think + Your Be + Your Do = What you have.)

Scripture:

Many (not all) of our issues or problems originate within us. Our thoughts, and our beliefs, will dictate our actions rightly or wrongly. Additionally, "we are led by whatever we are full of." Anger, hurt, anxiety, doubt, So, let us be led by the fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22 rather than to "be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. Romans 12:2. And "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty." 2 Corinthians 6:18

- 1. What does it mean to "think" Spirit led? (Read Romans 8:12-17)
- 2. What does it mean to be a core values-based person?
- 3. By thinking Spirit led and being a core values-based person how can you make a masterpiece of your life?

Prayer:
