#### **Review the Sunday Sermon notes**

On Sunday at the Point Loma campus, Pastor Travis opened his message by letting us know that being called to more isn't about possessions, but having a lifestyle that God has called us to live. He then shared a story about the types of phone calls that he receives. The first call was one he received when he was working out at the gym. The contact on his cell phone read, "Telemarketer". He did not pick up that call. But he did share that calls from his wife are always received. He even talked about calls that he never picks up from "Do not answer," because the person on the other end always causes him drama.

Finally, he stated that in life you will get calls from everywhere and everybody but the one that you decide to answer is what matters. We need to answer the call that God has placed on our lives.

### Discuss the following statements in your rGroup regarding ways that God speaks:

- As a group, read Daniel 3:1-30 (The Story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego)
  - 1. Answering God's call takes COURAGE. Has God called you to take a step of courage in an area of your life? Have you taken that step? What is holding you back? After you took a step of courage, what was the result?
  - 2. Answering God's call requires FAITH. Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego had faith in God despite their circumstances. What obstacles are you facing right now that require faith in God?
  - 3. Answering God's call produces MORE. On Sunday, Pastor Travis gave the challenge to sign up to serve in ministry. Are you serving in ministry? Has God given you a burden for a particular group of people to minister to? Have you learned more about your giftings through the LIFE Class? Where will you serve?
