Recite the Do Something Disciple Prayer

Sermon Application from Sunday's Message:

 - o Read 2 Corinthians 5:17. What is the significance of being new in Christ?
- Pastor Vince share about the story of Joseph in Genesis 50.
 - Read Genesis 50: 12-21. Joseph showed us a great example of what forgiveness looks like. In our lives how do we learn to listen to God, let go of our circumstance, and leave the outcome to God?
- Pastor Mike shared from Colossians 3:12-13.
 - Read Colossians 3:12-13. As the body of Christ how do we view each other as family and forgive each other?
- Pastor Mario shared from Ephesians 4:31-32.
 - o Read Ephesians 4:31-32. What do each of the statements below mean to you?
 - Forgive others the way you want to be forgiven.
 - Remember to ask for forgiveness.
 - Forgiveness is a journey not a destination.
