## **Sermon Application from Sunday's Message:**

Pastor Miles preached from Matthew 7:3-5. He spoke about Blind Spots and that we all have things that we just don't know. We need to take a humble position and be a humble listener. We have to honor what we have in common. We have to repent of our pride and surrender ourselves to God. All of us must admit that we have a blind spot. We have to remove the blind spots from our lives which will help us all to become more unified under God.

## Take time to read through the following statements and discuss the questions below in your group:

- A blind spot is being unaware of what we cannot see. For example, when we drive in a car we are all trained to look out for the blind spots so that we don't get in an accident. We all have blind spots.
  - What blind spots do you think you may have in regards to your social awareness of other cultures or ethnicities?
- We all must admit that we do have blind spots and many of them may be written by our social narrative. Our social narrative is the story that shapes our view of the world. Sometimes we can be racially offensive without knowing it.
  - o In your group, share about your life experience as it relates to your ethnicity and how it has shaped your view of the world.
- Finally, in order to ensure that we are moving towards unity we must love above all else.
  - o In your group, read Matthew 7:3-5 and discuss what it means to "first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye."
