D12 Monthly Focus for September: Guided by the Word of God

## **Sermon Application from Sunday's Message:**

On Sunday 9/6, Pastor Jason spoke to us about Groups and being with people, just as Jesus was with His disciples. As a group, take time to read through the following and discuss the questions below.

#### Read Mark 6:7-13

And He called the twelve to *Himself*, and began to send them out two *by* two, and gave them power over unclean spirits. He commanded them to take nothing for the journey except a staff—no bag, no bread, no copper in *their* money belts—but to wear sandals, and not to put on two tunics. Also, He said to them, "In whatever place you enter a house, stay there till you depart from that place. And whoever will not receive you nor hear you, when you depart from there, shake off the dust under your feet as a testimony against them. Assuredly, I say to you, it will be more tolerable for Sodom and Gomorrah in the day of judgment than for that city!" So, they went out and preached that *people* should repent. And they cast out many demons, and anointed with oil many who were sick, and healed *them*.

# LEARN: Discipleship ministry begins with a CALL.

Proximity. Potential. Purpose. Every call has a purpose. God is calling you to invite someone into a purposeful relationship. Who has God put around you, a neighbor, family member, or friend, to begin a discipleship relationship?

### Read Luke 6:40

A disciple is not above his teacher, but everyone when he is fully trained will be like his teacher.

BECOME: Mentor from where you ARE, not where you want to be.

You have a lot to offer someone, with the Lord's leading. Experiences you have been through are testimonies of God's faithfulness in your life and can bring healing, restoration, and hope to others. Some will accept the message you have, but others will reject you, but be faithful in representing Christ. What are some ways you are helping train someone else to lead?

#### Read Genesis 1:28

And God blessed them. And God said to them, 'Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it."

# **MULTIPLY: Multiplication requires RISK and RELEASE.**

Be ready to "let go," knowing that you will have to release those you are leading, to begin mentoring and leading others. People will make mistakes, but continue to seek doing God's will despite your human failures, knowing that God will grow us into world-changers. Releasing is not cutting someone off. What are some fears keeping you from "letting people go to lead on their own?"
