D12 Monthly Focus for February: Gracefully gives and receives forgiveness.

In this message, Pastor Jason interviewed his wife and two married couples to learn more about their perspective of being parents and how parenting relates to their relationship with God. In your group, please discuss the questions/statements below.

- **Love is Knowing God** – A pre-requisite of biblical parenting is *having* a deep loving relationship with God. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9. In these verses, we remember how meaningful it is to teach our children the significance of knowing God. Why is knowing God so important in raising children?
- **Love is Modeled** – A practice of biblical parenting is *modeling* a deep loving relationship with God. Read Psalm 78:1-8. How do we model God’s love to our children?
- **Loved is Passed On** – A purpose of biblical parenting is *developing* children who remember God and put their trust in Him. Again, read Psalm 78:1-8. What would be some of the benefits of your children passing on the love of God to their own children?
