### **D12 Monthly Focus for March: Nurtures A Burden For Lost People**

*In this message, Pastor Miles challenges us to humbly fulfill the prophetic purpose for our lives. He focuses on LUKE 19:28-40, better known as the “Triumphal Entry,” where Jesus enters Jerusalem on a colt as He prepares to sacrifice His Life for our sins.*

**As a group, read Luke 19:28-40. Then discuss the questions and statements below:**

**1. We need to have the humility to submit to God’s timing. Read Luke 19:28-31**

In these verses, we see Jesus asking his disciples to bring Him a colt. Jesus didn’t request a horse and chariot, but a colt. Why would Jesus humble Himself to ride a colt, as He was about to enter to Jerusalem as King? In what way is God calling you to humble yourself and wait on His timing?

**2. As we follow Jesus, we must humbly live a life of self-denial. Read Luke 19:32-36**

In these verses, we see people who were spreading their coats on the road. This was considered an act of honor for announcing a king. What are you giving up to honor Jesus as King? Are you living a life of self-denial for the purposes of God?

**3. We must have the humility to endure being misunderstood. Read Luke 19: 37-40**

In these verses, we see the crowd rejoicing over Jesus as their Messianic King coming down the Mount of Olives for His “Triumphal Entry.” However, the Pharisees tell Jesus to rebuke His disciples as the Pharisees did not believe Jesus was the Messianic King. Why is it important to endure even though we may be misunderstood by others for our faith and actions?
