**Weaponized Worship
December 5, 2021**

**Monthly Discipleship Focus for December:
Passionately worships all of who You are.**

On Sunday, Pastor Miles began his new series. At the most fundamental level, worship is the act of declaring God worthy, and it is foundational to the Christian walk.

Read Mark 4:1-11, then review the statements and answer the questions below:

Worship is acknowledging the goodness of someone or something, and you are declaring their worthyship through praising or serving. A *weapon* is a tool used to destroy an enemy.

1. Your worship is weaponized by the one you **SUBMIT** your power to (Matthew 4:1-4). You have two worship options that are not equal: God (Creator) or Satan (Destroyer). Is it easier for you to take godly advice or worldly advice when making a decision?
2. Your worship is weaponized by the one you try to **IMPRESS** (Matthew 4:5-7). When you're trying to impress people, the enemy tries to convince you you're better off making others happy, instead of pleasing God. In what ways could you live a more God-honoring life?
3. Your worship is weaponized by whose **FAVOR** you seek (Matthew 4:8-11). We need to know when the enemy is at work and flee from him. How easy or difficult is it for you to recognize the enemy's tactics as he tries to lure you away from God's ways?
