Serve with humility

This 6-part series explores traditions that Christians have been practicing for centuries such as fasting, sabbath, reflection, and baptism. In Part 5, Pastor Alli reviews the story of David and Bathsheba to teach us how to conquer our sin through confession.

Read 2 Samuel 11:1-5 and 12:7-13, review the following statements and questions, then briefly respond:

- 1. Where do I need to be?** Some of our greatest pitfalls do not have to do with other people, but with the environment in which we put ourselves. Briefly share about one place you know you should not have been.
- 2. Identify one person that can help you see your sin.** Although there are lots of people in our lives, whom can you trust to give you loving correction when you seem to have veered off track?
- 3. Know who you are.** There is a lot of confusion in this world and many have identity issues. Share your favorite scripture that reminds you of who you are in Christ.
- 4. Know who God is.** Things change so often in our lives and even though we may not understand all that transpires, God remains the same. Share the title of, or one to two sentences, of your favorite worship song or hymn that speaks directly to your heart.
