Mother's Day at the Rock

Monthly Discipleship Focus for May

Demonstrates a commitment to a Spirit-filled expression of my gifts.

In this message, Pastor Miles reviews the story of the Widow's Olive Oil to encourage you to consecrate everything you have to God so He will multiply it.

Based on the [broadcast message](#), read 2 Kings 4:1-7, review the following statements and questions below, then briefly respond accordingly.

1. Consecrate your **WORSHIP** to God (Matthew 13-14). Don't let your worship to God blend in with everything else in your life. Set your priorities on God, knowing that He is the provider of all your needs. What's your favorite worship song or hymn – share the lyrics of a specific verse or chorus that speaks to your heart.
2. Consecrate your **NOTHING** to God (2 Kings 4:2, Romans 11:29). Don't ever think that what God has given you or left you with, is not significant. Give an example where you felt you were down to *nothing* and God turned it into *something*.
3. Consecrate God **OPPORTUNITY** to God (2 Kings 4:3). Outward appearances don't mean anything because God looks at the heart. Give yourself a chance to be whom God called you to be. Briefly share about an opportunity in your life that you know happened only because of the Lord.
4. Consecrate your **PRIVACY** with God (2 Kings 4:4, Matthew 6:6, Luke 9:18-20, Matthew 14:23-24). God blesses you publicly based on what you do privately. Ask for help if needed. Spend time alone with God so he can pour into you, but he can't if you're distracted by all the things going on in your life. When do you find alone time with God and how can you make it better (examples: before the kids wake up for school, solo drive time, before going to bed, etc.)?
5. Consecrate your **VESSEL** to God (2 Kings 4:5-7). Have more faith that God will do the filling of your empty vessels. Briefly share which of the following you will be in prayer for yourself, whether you need healing, revelation, a baby, forgiveness, a career, deliverance, or something else, that God would pour out His heavenly blessings upon you.

This Month's Memory Verse: 1 Corinthians 14:1 (NKJV)

Pursue love, and desire spiritual gifts, but especially that you may prophesy.
