Monthly Discipleship Focus for May

Based on the <u>broadcast message</u>, read Luke 10:38-42, review the following statements and questions below, then briefly respond accordingly.

- 1. Get a **COMMUNITY** / **GROUP** (Luke 10:38). The enemy will do everything he can to get you off track with the Lord. But having a community of people can help you stay on course. What do you enjoy most about being in a group?
- 2. Hear the **WORD** (Luke 10:39). In a group, you're able to talk about the Word of God and study the Bible. Think about and read a scripture reference that the Holy Spirit has led you to, especially as you may have recently been through a trial.
- 3. Be **ACCOUNTABLE** (Luke 10:40-42). Life is difficult and sometimes we get so busy doing things that they can cause us to worry. Do you have an accountability partner you can call at any time if you're dealing with an issue or need prayer?
