A Heart for the House is a Jealous Heart October 30, 2022

In part three of this series, we will learn four components of a Jealous Heart which desires exclusivity in a relationship.

Based on the <u>broadcast message</u> filmed at the Point Loma campus, read 2 Samuel 6:12-23, review the following statements and questions below, then briefly respond accordingly within your group:

- 1. A Jealous heart HUNGERS to praise God (2 Samuel 6:12) David desired the blessing that came with God's presence so much so that he sought to bring the ark to the City of David. Are you hungry for God's presence? If so, what is the evidence?
- 2. A Jealous heart praises God SHAMELESSLY (2 Samuel 6:14-16) David was unashamed to fully surrender to his desire to praise God. Do you find yourself reserved when it comes to worship?
- **3.** A Jealous heart's praise produces blessing OVERFLOW (2 Samuel 6:18-20) God's blessings are so great, we feel compelled to give as He has given to us. Where have you seen this in your life?
- 4. A Jealous heart praises for God's APPROVAL (2 Samuel 6:20-23) David's worship was unreserved and unashamed. Our worship can sometimes be questioned by others who may not yet understand. Has this happened to you and were you willing to praise Him anyway?
