A Heart for the House is a Prepared Heart November 6, 2022

In part four of this series, Pastor Miles explains how to prepare our hearts to worship God as David planned for the future temple for the ark of God.

Based on the <u>broadcast message</u> filmed at the Point Loma campus, review the following statements and questions below, then briefly respond accordingly within your group:

- 1. A prepared heart understands the focus of the House (1 Chronicles 29:1; Acts 13:22) We say this because when you have a heart after HIS heart we will do what HE wants us to do, and we're ready to do it...whatever it is. Share one area of your life, where you feel like you're still holding on, unwilling to let go. We know to share this, it takes a moment of courage, so go ahead TRUST HIM. What needs to happen to trust HIM more?
- 2. A prepared heart allocates resources for the House. (1 Chronicles 29:2; Matthew 6:19-21) When we put God's desires ahead of our own, we are willing to use what HE has given us to bless HIM. What practical step can you take, or is GOD calling you to take to provide for HIS house?
- 3. Take a moment to acknowledge each other with affirmations supporting areas you have trusted HIM with tonight. Thank God for ALL he is doing and WILL do in your life because you have trusted HIM. Pray for one another in what you hope GOD WILL do.
