A Heart for the House is a Prepared Heart (part 2) November 13, 2022

This 6-week series focuses on the discipleship values we want to cultivate. In Part 5, Pastor Miles focuses on four aspects of a prepared heart that gives to God's house as David arranged for the future temple.

Based on the <u>broadcast message</u>, review the following statements and questions below, then briefly respond accordingly within your group:

- 1. A prepared heart understands the focus of the House (1 Chronicles 29:1). When we turn our focus to the Lord, it changes what we do. What are you working on right now, that changes it if you look at it as though it is an offering to God? Sometimes a slight shift in perspective changes everything...
- 2. A prepared heart allocates resources for the House (1 Chronicles 29:2). When we understand we are providing for God's use, we make choices that support what we claim is important. Are you willing to allocate resources for the 'House' God has provided you?
- 3. A prepared heart directs its affections towards God's house (1 Chronicles 29:3-5). It's as simple as this...where your heart is, your treasure is. Do you feel God encouraging you to align your actions with your heart? Be honest, God will minister to you...
- 4. A prepared heart gives willingly (1 Chronicles 29:5-9). When you are clear about where your heart is focused, you support it willingly and joyfully. Ask God to reveal anything that is preventing you from giving willingly. Share it...be courageous and vulnerable.
