Do Something Is Our Response
February 26, 2023

This 11-week series dives into the important discipleship values that shape our church. In Part 7, Pastor Miles explains Rock Church's "do something" value, reviews how Rock Church responds to community needs, and interviews three active church members.

In your group, read Luke 13:10-17, review the statements below, then respond accordingly:

1. **Be aware of the needs** (around you). Ask God to open your eyes this week to take notice of the needs in your neighborhood, workplace, or community, and pray that God would reveal to you which area could use your help or direction. Briefly share one or two areas you already know of that God has spoken to you about .
2. **Go to the needs** (bringing the presence, peace, reconciliation, and the love of God to every conversation and confrontation). Is there a specific person God is putting on your heart to reach out to, but you're too scared to do so? It could be a family member, neighbor, co-worker. Don't just invite people to church, but see what their need is and ask God how you can help.
3. **Meet the needs** (to the best of your ability). Do your part to help somebody else... the people outside (and inside) of the church building walls. Have you served in your community? Such as hand out or donate food, deliver blankets, coach a youth sports team, visit the elderly, do some area cleanup, etc. Share a quick story on how your service to others has helped strengthen your own faith.
