Generosity is Our Privilege

This 11-week series dives into the important discipleship values that shape our church. In Part 8, Pastor Miles discusses the benefits reaped from having a generous heart perspective and giving generously towards God's kingdom..

In your group, review the statements below then respond accordingly:

- 1) **Kingdom rewards are sent ahead** (1 Timothy 6:6-7). Briefly disclose some things you may have that are significant or hold sentimental value to you, such as writings, coins, photos, collections, and more. When you leave this earth, you cannot take anything with you.
- 2) **Kingdom rewards are put into your account** (Philippians 4:14-16). Think about a time you helped someone else in need and share with the group how it made you feel.
- 3) **Kingdom rewards are brought by Jesus** (Revelation 22:12-13). Describe a recent or past event where God called you, by faith, to do something and you didn't have all the details. We aren't supposed to go do things because we expect a return, but rather just do what He's telling you to, knowing that:
 1. Kingdom rewards are 100% secure (Matthew 6:19-21)
 2. Kingdom rewards are affordable (Matthew 10:40-42)
 3. Kingdom rewards are intended to be enjoyed twice (Luke 18:28-30)
 4. Kingdom rewards are used to worship Jesus (Revelation 4:9-11)
