Broken Romance

This series highlights how God exchanges our brokenness for something beautiful. In Part 2, Pastor Travis presents four relationship steps to take to become the right person so the right person will commit to you.

In your group, read Ruth 3:1-11, review the statements below, then respond accordingly:

1. **Know My WORTH** (Psalm 139:14, 1 Corinthians 6:20). You are a masterpiece. You are valuable. If you don't know your own identity, someone else will try to tell you who you are and whose you are. Do you know that you are wonderfully and fearfully made or has the enemy used someone to convince you otherwise?
2. **Get My VISION** (Proverbs 29:18). When you have no prophetic revelation, you just do whatever you want because there is no standard to uphold. Take a moment to think about your future. Briefly share one or two things that you have declared, written down, and prayed about.
3. **Set My EXPECTATIONS** (Habakkuk 2:2). Do you know what you desire, what you want your spouse to be: Do they love Jesus? Are you attracted to them? Do they go to church? Do they have a job? Are they responsible? Are they kind to their family? Share with the group one or two more expectations you may have that are not listed above.
4. **Unpack My BAGGAGE** (Hebrews 12:1). That "thing" that always weighs you down, how much longer do you want to walk around with it: unforgiveness, bitterness, resentment, anxiety, or something else? The only one who has the power to hold and manage your baggage is Jesus. Ask the group to pray for you regarding specific baggage which you haven't let go, knowing that God offers wholeness and forgiveness of sin as you surrender your broken romance to Jesus.
