Money Multipier September 10, 2023

This 3-week series unpacks the relationship between faith and finances, focusing on the powerful truth that generosity is not a burden – it's our privilege! In Part 3, Pastor Miles encourages you to give to God first with your finances, to open the door for God to bless your finances.

In your group, read Galatians 6:7-9, Ephesians 4:22-23, and Exodus 13:11-16. Review the points below, then discuss accordingly:

1. Honor God by giving to Him FIRST (Proverbs 3:9-10, Exodus 22:29)

Discussion: God wants the first fruits of your labor, not the leftovers. Think of everything good you have in your life, then briefly share one or two things you know are from God.

2. Giving God first secures a BLESSING on the rest (Romans 11:16)

Discussion: Begin to be more mindful of what you give to God - a tip, a tithe (10%), or an offering (above 10%). Give an example of when you willfully gave and received an unexpected blessing (job offer, good news, etcetera).

3. Giving God first demonstrates faith of MORE TO COME (1 Corinthians 15:20-23, Malachi 3:9-10)

Discussion: If you hold on to something that belongs to God, then you are like a thief and cannot be trusted with more. If you currently do not tithe or give any amount, pray about changing your attitude and test Him: give for 90-days to see if you receive blessings that you cannot explain. If you currently tithe, pray to God if He wants you to give above your tithe in order to bless others.
