FOUR KEYS TO GOD'S WILL

- 1. God's plans are worth finding out.
- 2. Discovering His will is not an exact science, it requires practice.
- 3. God has more time, resources and ideas than we can imagine.
- 4. Discovering God's will is a process.

FIVE WAYS GOD REVEALS HIS WILL TO US

1. God speaks through in prayer:
1. God speaks throughin prayer: John 16:13 "However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own authority, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.
2. God speaks through His
(Judges 6). Often God's blessing and circumstances are His way or us of His will for our lives.
3. God speaks through: Proverbs 15:22
Without counsel, plans go awry, but in the multitude of counselors they are established. Develop relationships with
who can help you discover God's plan for your life.
4. God speaks through
(Luke 2 and Matt 2) God used dreams to tell Zechariah and Joseph, the fathers of John the Baptist and Jesus, about the coming births of their sons. Write out your visions and dreams and compare them to other messages He is giving you.
5. God speaks through both written and spoken: God's will never contradicts His Word. The Bible will shed light on every decision you can make. The trick is to know how to use it your advantage.
