

#### Not Like Any Other Man Judges 13-16 March 16, 2003

#### I. THE SEPARATE-NESS OF SAMSON'S LIFE

- A. Nazarite: Separated or consecrated to God for a special purpose; the crowned one.
- B. A Nazarite vow: Voluntary separateness, for a <u>specific</u> time period, in most cases.
  - 1. They did not drink the fruit of the <u>vine</u>.
  - 2. They did not <u>cut</u> their hair.
  - 3. They did not come into contact with a <u>corpse</u>
- C. Three men were Nazarites for life:
  - 1. John the Baptist Anointed messenger ; Luke 1
  - 2. Samuel Anointed <u>leader</u>; 1 Samuel 1
  - 3. Samson Anointed judge ; Judges 13

# II. THE SPECIAL-NESS OF SAMSON'S BIRTH

- A. Samson was called a Nazarite from the womb. Judges 13:5
- B. Samson's mother, like the mothers of John and Samuel, was <u>barren</u> and given a son for a special <u>purpose</u>.
  Eph. 1:3-5
- C. Samson's mother received a divine visit from the Angel of the Lord. Judges 13:17-22

### III. THE SUPERNATURAL-NESS OF SAMSON'S POWER

- A. He killed a <u>lion</u> with his bare hands. Judges 14:6-9
- B. He killed <u>30 men</u>, then took their clothes to pay off a bet. v. 14:19

- C. He caught 300 foxes and burned grain fields. v. 15:4-5
- D. He killed 1,000 men with a donkey jawbone. v. 15:14-16

**Remember:** Samson <u>knew</u> where his strength came from and that it made him different.

Judges 16:11 "... then I shall become weak, and be like any other man." See Matt 11:7-11 Do you know how to access what God has for you?

> Great strength is available to all of us. Acts 1:8 Many of us are <u>powerless</u> Samsons.

# **IV-THE SADNESS OF SAMSON'S DOWNFALL** 16:6-21

Four warnings for the powerless Samson:

A. Samson did not <u>honor</u> and protect his strength. <u>Guard</u> your heart. Proverbs 4:23

Your spiritual vow and commitment is sacred\_\_\_\_\_ to God.

- B. Samson was unequally yoked with Delilah. 2 Corinthians 6:14The enemy does not always <u>look</u> like the enemy.
- C. Samson took God's grace for granted.

Are you thankful\_\_\_\_\_ for what God has done in your life?

D. Samson allowed himself to be <u>vexed</u>.

Avoid <u>exposure</u> to temptation. Psalms 1:1
