Spiritual deliverance Salvation -Complete sinfulness **Depravity** -**Born again** - Spiritual birth as opposed to physical birth No longer guilty before God. Rom 5:1-2 Justified -Guilt and shame removed forever Forgiven -Adoption -To be brought into God's family Gospel -Good news **Propitiation** - The satisfaction of God's justice through atonement.
