A NEW CREATION

- Union with Christ Being "in Christ"
- Christ and the believer form <u>one body.</u> (Eph 5:29-32, 1 Cor 6:15-17)
- A union that God initiates and in which we participate. (John 15:5-8)
- A union to last through death.
 - o We died with Christ...(Rom 6:4)
 - o We will resurrect with Christ...(Rom 6:5)
 - o We were crucified with Him. (Rom 6:6)
- If joined to Christ, we possess all the spiritual blessings available.
 - o Eph 1:3 Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every <u>spiritual blessing</u> in the heavenly places in Christ.

A NEW HEART

•	Regeneration sets your heart to live for God. You are no longer a slave to sin.

•	Ambassadors could not go beyond the letter of their instructions. God.
•	The Ambassador's duty was limited to the delivering of a message and the receiving of an answer.
