	We live a life of discovering our sanctification, not a		
	life of working for it.		
	Therefore, if a man <u>cleanses</u> himself from these things, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work. (2 Tim 2:21)		
b.	Hard work – Therefore I run in such a way as not without aim; I box in such a way as not beating the air; but I buffet my body and make it my slave, lest possible, after I have preached to others, I myself should be disqualified. (1Cor 9:26-27) The hardest work at times is the discipline to say no to things we love.		
c.	Remember it's a process – Sanctification takes a lifetime. Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ (Phil 1:6)		
	God provides "Sanctification power". (v. 9 – 10)		
	Sanctification is a work of God in which believers cooperate. – For it is God who is at work in you, both to will and do work for His good pleasure. (Phil 2:13)		
	• God works in us the <u>desire</u> for sanctification.		
	God establishes the <u>blessings</u> and <u>motivation</u> associated with sanctification.		
	God provides the <u>resources</u> for your sanctification <u>mission</u> .
