FORGIVENESS BASICS

FORGIVENESS: • The willingness to release someone from the responsibility of paying the debt of healing our pain
• The act of <u>excusing</u> or pardoning someone's sins
• Sin is remembered <u>no more</u> . (Jer 31:34)
• The <u>separation</u> of us from our sins and their consequences (Ps 103:11-12)
• Cleansed from <u>unrighteousness</u> (1 John 1:9)
THREE 'SIN NO MORE' PRINCIPLES The command - Sin no more So that you may walk in a manner
worthy of the God who calls you into His own kingdom and glory. (1Thes 2:12).
 Since we all know we have sin and need forgiveness, decide that sin is wrong. (Verse 9)
• The religious <u>rationalized</u> sin.
• The religious gossiped and judged the woman. (Matt 7:1-5)
