

Abraham, Father of Faith Supernatural Turning Point May 16, 2004

A **supernatural** and laughable <u>pronouncement</u> was made to Abraham and Sarah. (Genesis 17:17, 18:13)

Believers in Christ are encouraged to *dream* beyond laughable proportions. (Ephesians 3:20)

A supernatural purpose is marked by a new name.

Believers in Christ are called *Christians*. (Acts 11:26)

A **supernatural** parting from the world is marked by circumcision.

Believers in Christ have circumcised *hearts*. (Romans 2:28-29)

A supernatural provision of the Promised Land was made.

Believers in Christ are blessed with God's *provision*. (Matthew 6:28-34)

The **supernatural** <u>preparation</u> of Sarah's body enabled her to have a son at 90 years of age.

Believers in Christ are blessed with *spiritual gifts*. (1 Corinthians 12)

A **supernatural** <u>prerogative</u> was given to Abraham. (Genesis 17:1) "I am Almighty God; walk before Me and be blameless."
