

10 – 10 Commandments Exodus 19-24 November 21, 2004

- 1. Author of Commandments: God
- 2. Place: Mt. Sinai, where Moses spent 40 days
- 3. Method of Transmission: written on two sides of stone tablets by the <u>finger</u> of God
- 4. Delivered twice because of the golden calf incident
- 5. Home of the Commandments: <u>Ark</u> of the Covenant in the Holy of <u>Holies</u>
- 6. Organization of the Commandments:

Four focused on our relationship with God.

1st God is one.

2nd God is spirit.

3rd God's name must be <u>respected</u>.

4th God must be worshipped regularly.

Six focused on our relationship with people.

5th Honor your <u>parents.</u>

6th Honor human life.

7th Honor your marriage covenant.

8th Honor the property of others.

9th Honor the <u>character</u> of others.

10th Honor your <u>emotional</u> boundaries.

- 7. Purpose of the Law: to lead us to repentance.
- 8. Limitations of the Commandments: they cannot <u>change</u> our hearts.
- 9. Jesus affirmed the validity of commandments.
- 10. Jesus came to <u>fulfill</u> the commandments.
