## **Lord of the Things**

- Mission Statement: The Rock Church exists to <u>save</u>, <u>equip</u>, and <u>send</u> out soulwinners for Jesus Christ.
- 2. Vision: A picture of your preferred <u>future</u>. *Matthew* 28:19-20
- 3. Vision Statement: The vision of the Rock Church is to be a powerful <a href="evangelistic">evangelistic</a> force that <a href="enagges">enagges</a> every segment of society as a motivated <a href="ARMY">ARMY</a> of believers in Jesus Christ. We are wholeheartedly committed to using our gifts <a href="anywhere">anywhere</a>, at <a href="anytime">anytime</a> to share the Gospel, while influencing and transforming our culture. This "force" will <a href="evangelize">evangelize</a> San Diego and empower other churches to use this ministry model around the world.
- **4.** Lord of the Things: A series on personal <u>stewardship</u> and a guide to the biblical <u>management</u> of the resources with which God has blessed you.
- **5.** Lordship: The practice of <u>complete</u> submission to Jesus as owner and <u>controller</u> of all things pertaining to your life. Partial obedience is the same as my <u>complete</u> disobedience
- **6.** True lordship requires us to completely <u>let go</u> and hand over control of our lives to the Lord
- 7. Our Lord places a high value on His expectation for high profit.
- **8.** Fasting is an act of self-denial for a specific purpose and period of time.
- **9.** Why fast? To secure access to supernatural resources. *Mark* 9:29
- **10.** Why food? What gives you an "attitude" if withheld from you? *Matthew 6:33*
- 11. Never complain or brag about your fast.

## **Salvation ARMY**

- **A** Be involved in an <u>Accountability</u> relationship. We need someone to help us resist the temptation to bow to the pressures of the world.
- **R** Be committed to <u>Reaching</u> out to the lost by living an <u>evangelistic</u> lifestyle.
  - When Jesus called Matthew, he was making a living as a <u>tax collector</u>. He said, follow Me and Matthew got up <u>immediately</u> and followed Him.
  - Matthew hosted a Matthew party called a MARTY.
  - Jesus said, "For I have not come to call the righteous, but <u>sinners</u> to <u>repentance</u>." *Matthew 9:13*
  - Matthew uses over 120 <u>Old Testament</u> verses to confirm that Jesus is the Messiah.
- M Be involved in <u>Ministry</u> and service. Ministry to the least of these is about loving people who cannot <u>pay</u> you back, and serving without any <u>expectation</u> of receiving recognition for it.
- Y Trust God with the management of 'Yo' Money. Our biblical financial commitment to the church is called a <u>tithe</u>. A tithe is <u>10</u>% of your income, and an offering is anything over and above that.

## Who is Jesus Really?

- 1. Uniqueness of the Bible: <u>66</u> books, 39 OT and 27 NT books, all written over <u>1500</u> years by over <u>40</u> authors in <u>3</u> different continents about <u>100's</u> of topics.
- 2. A document is considered ancient if written before the invention of the <u>printing press</u>, in the mid-<u>1400s</u>. An ancient document is considered reliable if there are <u>seven</u> copies within <u>1000</u> years of the original.
- **3.** The Bible has more <u>manuscript</u> evidence than all the other ancient documents combined.
- **4.** If the Bible is God's Word it must be <u>historically</u> and <u>scientifically</u> accurate and most of all, <u>spiritually</u> effective to change your life.
- **5.** Gospel means good news, which is that Jesus died to save sinners.
- **6.** Synoptic means "seen together". These three Gospels, <u>Matthew</u>, <u>Mark</u>, and Luke, have over 50% of the same information.
- 7. The accuracy of the Gospels is not dependent on the <u>intelligence</u> or education of the writers but their submission to the <u>Holy Spirit</u>.
- **8.** We know the disciples intended to write accurate history because they <u>walked</u> <u>away</u> from all they had to follow Him, taught <u>controversial</u> topics, had their lives <u>transformed</u> and <u>died</u> for what they believed.
- **9.** Theophany means an appearance of Jesus before man in the OT.
- **10.** One of the titles for Jesus in the OT is "Angel of the Lord".
- **11.** Jesus expressed His Divine name, "<u>I AM</u>", or Yahweh, while speaking from the fire of the burning bush.
- **12.** Trinity: A word expressing the three-member team or Godhead we call God.
- **13.** Each member has a distinct <u>purpose</u> and role:

Father: As the Almighty One, He establishes the plan of salvation.

Son: As the Mediator, He <u>executes</u> the plan's contract in blood.

Holy Spirit: As the Helper, He <u>implements</u> the plan, sealing it with His presence.

- **14.** The ways we learned that Jesus claimed His own deity were:
  - He accepted worship and displayed supernatural power through miracles.
  - He claimed to have <u>authority</u> over things in <u>heaven</u> and gave Himself <u>titles</u> that belong to God.
  - He demonstrated, in His teaching, <u>authority</u> over the OT Law by saying, "But I say unto you..."
  - He made <u>after-life</u> promises and exercised God's <u>authority</u> by doing things such as forgiving sins.
- **15.** Jesus' critics did more to <u>validate</u> His claims than disprove them. They confirmed His claim to be God by accusing Him of <u>blasphemy</u>.
- **16.** Blasphemy means to speak <u>evil</u> of someone or attribute the <u>Divine</u> attributes of God to man.
- **17.** They confirmed His claims to rise from the dead by <u>guarding</u> the tomb.
- **18.** Satan and the demons were once <u>angels</u> who were cast out of heaven because of <u>pride</u>.
- **19.** Satan and the demons confessed that Jesus was the <u>Christ</u>, the Holy One, and that they were to be sent to judgment by Jesus.
