4. Cults rely on material <u>other than</u> the Bible as their source of truth.

The Bible is the only book that claims to be supernatural, Matthew 24:10-14 life changing, and embodying the integrity of Jesus Himself.

5. Cults follow <u>false</u> prophets who preach a <u>false</u> gospel offering salvation by works.
